A peer review process will be used to evaluate all papers submitted for consideration. If a paper is accepted, at least one author needs to register and present the paper.

Your submission will be double-blind reviewed by at least two independent reviewers. The decision on your paper will be informed via CMT

Submission Guidelines

General instructions:

- 1. Authors are required to remove header and footer (if there any) in their Final Cameraready manuscript.
- 2. Do not put any page numbers in the Camera-ready manuscript.
- 3. Remove the titles like (Prof., Dr., Mr., Ms., etc..) before the author's name(s)
- 4. Remove hyperlinks (if there any) in the final version of the manuscripts
- 5. Format the paper using IEEE standard template.

Required instructions:

- 1) CAMERA READY/FINAL MANUSCRIPT (on or before October 31, 2025)
- 2) IEEE eCOPYRIGHT form via email received from acceptance mail (on or before October 31, 2025)
- 3) Registration form Duly completed (on or before October 31, 2025)
