

Author Guidelines

Authors are required to follow all the instructions listed under General and Required category for final submission of their manuscript to IEEE Xplore.

Papers submitted to AIST 2025 shall contain original work by the author(s) that have not been published or submitted for publication elsewhere. The IEEE anti- plagiarism policy is applicable to all submissions. The author(s) are solely responsible for any plagiarized submission.

A peer review process will be used to evaluate all papers submitted for consideration. If a paper is accepted, at least one author needs to register and present the paper.

Your submission will be double-blind reviewed by at least two independent reviewers. The decision on your paper will be informed according to the schedule.

Submission Guidelines

General instructions:

- 1. Authors are required to remove header and footer (if there any) in their Final Camera- ready manuscript.
- 2. Do not put any page numbers in the Camera-ready manuscript.
- 3. Remove the titles like (Prof., Dr., Mr., Ms., etc..) before the author's name(s)
- 4. Remove hyperlinks (if there any) in the final version of the manuscripts
- 5. Format the paper using IEEE standard template.

Required instructions:

- 1) CAMERA READY/FINAL MANUSCRIPT (on or before October 31, 2025)
- 2) Registration form Duly completed (on or before October 31, 2025)

1. IEEE PDF format CAMERA READY SUBMISSION

- **STEP 1:** Revise your paper(s) according to the reviewers' comments failing which it will be REJECTED.
- **STEP 2:** Download the IEEE Camera Ready Template for AIST-2025.

The authors are required to use the standard IEEE manuscript template for conferences. The Microsoft Word template in can be downloaded from IEEE conference template page:

- The paper length should not exceed six (6) pages, IEEE two (2) column format. You need to modify your paper exactly as per the format requirements specified in the Camera-Ready Format.

Plagiarism Policy

AIST-2025 takes plagiarism very seriously and regards plagiarism as a professional misconduct. Papers will be screened for plagiarism and when identified the paper will be rejected. Only those papers will be carry forwarded to next step of the review which are initially detected for plagiarism of less than 10%. No AI Based Content like ChatGPT will be allowed. If at any stage find AI tool content, the paper will be rejected even after successful registration.
